Dr. Mahadevan is an associate professor of medicine at The University of Arizona College of Medicine. He specializes in medical oncology and internal medicine.

Dr. Mahadevan received his medical degree from King's College Hospital Medical School in the United Kingdom. He completed a residency in internal medicine at the University of Connecticut Health Sciences Center and a fellowship in hematologic oncology at the Arizona Cancer Center.

Dr. Mahadevan also serves as director of drug development and director of the Phase I Clinical Trials Research Team for the Arizona Cancer Center. His scientific research has focused on prostate cancer, pancreatic cancer, myelodysplastic syndrome and drug design. His clinical research has centered on improving the treatment of patients with solid tumors, colorectal cancer and gastro-intestinal stromal tumors.

Dr. Mahadevan is certified by the American Board of Internal Medicine.
