NAMING OPPORTUNITIES AT UMC NORTH

The Peter and Paula Fasseas Cancer Clinic has two floors. The ground floor contains the heart of the clinic: three clinical pavilions, one dedicated to the Division of Women's Cancers and the remaining two to cancers generally, including men's cancers and lymphomas. Each pavilion has its own registration and waiting area, examination rooms, workrooms, and adjoining atrium. Also on this first floor are the lobby and main registration area, a boutique, a café, a radiology suite, procedure and conference rooms, and numerous clinical support rooms.

The second floor houses registration and waiting areas, 18 infusion rooms, one examination room, a substantial clinical research area, a pharmacy, a laboratory, an administrative suite, and several staff-related rooms.

To the east of the building is the "Healing Garden," which, amid an expansive array of trees and plants, contains numerous areas for rest and contemplation, water features, bridges, and decorative walls.

The following menu lists all of the naming opportunities in and around the Fasseas Clinic, accompanied by their respective values. Those rooms already reserved by donors are so designated.
