



RN to BSN Program

University Medical Center is committed to the education and professional development of UMC nurses. As part of that commitment a program has been implemented to support RNs pursuing a bachelor of science in nursing (BSN) degree.

UMC has formed a partnership with Grand Canyon University (GCU). Classes are five weeks long and scheduled consecutively. The total program takes five semesters to complete. Thirty RNs will be sponsored per year. UMC will pay costs of tuition for core program courses directly to GCU.

Selection for participation is based on the following criteria:

- At least one year employment as an RN at UMC.
- Currently working in a .6 FTE or greater position.
- Recommendation of current supervisor.
- No disciplinary actions in HR file.

Nurses who participate in this program will be required to sign a commitment to continue working as an RN in a .6 or greater FTE position for two years after completion of the program.
