Several nationally-recognized leaders in Injury Prevention will present at the "First Annual Injury Symposium" in Mesa on June 16.

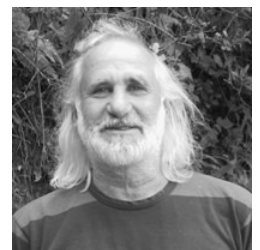
The focus of the symposium is on changing public policy in support of injury prevention.
